Dear Reader

Archbishop Sabbah says that the most important role for the Church in these troubled times is to support and cherish the faith of our children and ensure that they have a Christian education. You send the Trust most generous donations to fund student fees, teachers' salaries and urgent projects, which help maintain the schools in good condition. I am delighted to report that we have now raised over £110,000 for the education of Christians in the Holy Land. Well done.

As we recorded in our first newsletter, we have focused on three schools, which we support with a quarterly payment of £12,150. This covers 100 students and 15 teachers' salaries. When we hear from the priests and teachers in the Holy Land of specific urgent needs, we are able to help them from the project fund – which is happily growing apace. This newsletter features some of our successfully completed projects funded by the Trust over the past year.

Our main source of income comes from our parishes and it is our primary aim to seek to increase awareness in our parishes of the difficulties that the Christian Palestinians face in the Holy Land, with unemployment at 80% in many areas. We now have a resource pack to help with parish appeals, which includes a video and a set of posters. Please see details on the back page.

The Bishops in England and Wales are aware of this need and Archbishop Patrick Kelly of Liverpool has happily agreed to become our Patron:

"I am one of the Bishops in the Department for International Affairs and I have been asked to be part of the International coordination group seeking to walk with our sisters and brothers in the Holy Land. It will therefore be an honour and indeed in the best sense of the word a duty to accept your invitation to be a Patron of the Trust"

The Trustees express their deepest thanks to all who have been responsible for the contributions that continue to pour in from individuals, parishes and groups; from Catholic, Church of England, Methodist and Baptist parishes and other groups of persons moved by the plight of the Children of the Holy Land.

We pray constantly that the Holy Spirit will soon bring peace and progress towards justice for all who live in the land that saw the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Over £110,000 has now been raised and £87,320 sent out to the Holy Land schools during 2002 and 2003. £34,570 went to fund urgent maintenance projects.

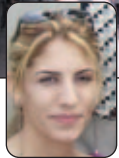

FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY: This shows how the money has been spent. (Note: Administrative costs are met by separate dedicated donations.)

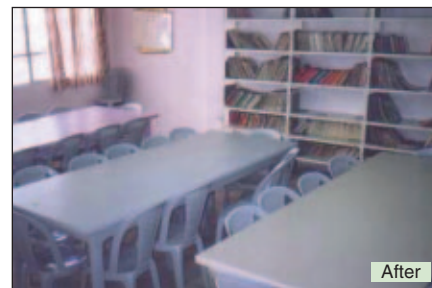


New Classroom Furniture:
